

Olympic Peninsula GeoTour 2

Let your GPS device guide you to some of the Olympic Peninsula's most spectacular locations!

To get started:

- Visit www.geocaching.com to set up a FREE account or download the geocaching app for your smart phone.
- Next, click www.geocaching.com/play/geotours to find the Olympic Peninsula GeoTour link.
- Then hit the road to find all 21 new geocaches hidden in some of the most spectacular scenery in the world!

Record your geocache finds by stamping each of the 21 squares and writing the code word found in each cache. Don't forget to log your finds on the geocaching website, too! When you've completed all 21 cache finds, fill out the information on the back of your passport and mail it in to receive a collectible geocoin to remember your adventure. One coin per household while supplies last. Be sure to keep a copy of your passport, and please allow 3-5 weeks for your geocoin to arrive. Now, let's get started!
